Additional Holiday Details:

All holidays falling on a standard workday will be observed that same day. Weekend holidays will be observed on the closest workday to the actual date of the observed holiday (prior if first day of the weekend, after if second day of weekend), with the exception of Israel. Standard work weeks for the US, Canada and Serbia are M-F. The standard work week for Israel is Su-Th. *Ex. Saturday, February 15 is a holiday in Serbia. That holiday will be observed on Friday, February 14.*
